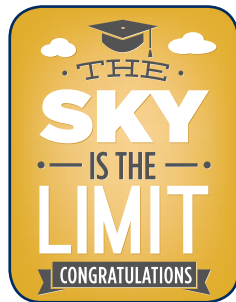


It's Scholarship Time!

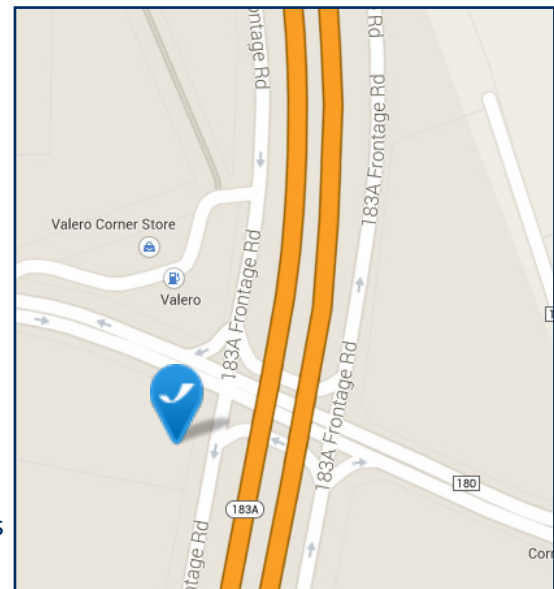
We bring you New Hope

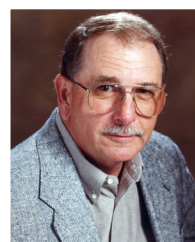
Board of Directors Announces Nominations & Annual Meeting
